Hi all,

I was hoping to please outline my experience in moving my HCL Domino Server from Windows to Ubuntu Linux. Overall, I am extremely pleased with moving to Ubuntu Linux as I found HCL Domino on Windows to be quite temperamental. I was using Windows Server on Azure, and I was increasingly becoming unsatisfied. The Azure portal was difficult to navigate, and I was having major troubles with the HCL Domino Server service, resulting in myself having to uninstall and reinstall the Domino server a handful of times.

Consequently, I moved to Ubuntu Linux, running up a Domino 14.5 server on a Docker instance. This is being hosted on DigitalOcean. So far, so good! I am in love with DigitalOcean's simple interface, accessing billing or adding firewall rules to Droplets is a breeze!

I recommend signing up and using DigitalOcean as your one-stop-shop! It is significantly cheaper compared to a similar spec'd Azure or AWS instance. Access DigitalOcean using my referral link here:
